Who does John see? What details interest or surprise you?

What are the seven lampstands?

**Revelation 1:20** As for the mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand, and the seven golden lampstands, the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

What does John call this revelation?

What is John describing? How do we interpret this?

## **Revelation 22:1-5**

What is John describing?

**Isaiah 41:18-20** I will open rivers on the bare heights, and fountains in the midst of the valleys. I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water. I will put in the wilderness the cedar, the acacia, the myrtle, and the olive. I will set in the desert the cypress, the plane and the pine together, that they may see and know, may consider and understand together, that the hand of the LORD has done this, the Holy One of Israel has created it.
