
Pastor Pool's Sunday Bible Study The Footsteps of Paul

The Church Year: Celebrating the Saints

The first Sunday in Advent is November 30. The paraments turn blue. We count the days until we celebrate the Incarnation. The church slows down and becomes more

reflective and repentant. And we have a new emphasis for our devotion as the church year begins.

Our emphasis this church year will be *Celebrating the Saints*. We have a new resource for your devotions with this title by Rev. William Weedon. Copies are available to purchase for \$20. But you can also find the Kindle version on Amazon for just \$9.99.

This is not exactly a daily devotion. It has readings for the beginning of each season in the church year. But it also has readings for all of the feasts, festivals, and commemorations. These special days are all listed in the hymnal. And it will take a proactive approach to pay attention to when these days fall in the calendar and church year. I will incorporate some of these feast days into Sunday Divine Services.

There isn't a devotion for every single day. I recommend filling in the other days with your Bible reading, past devotionals (like *To Live With Christ* by Bo Giertz), or get a copy of *Faith Alone* by Martin Luther (we can order this for you too).

My goal is to see our connection to the saints that have come before us. We have a rich tradition and heritage. In addition, we have many good examples of steadfast faith and love in the Scriptures and throughout church history. This new devotion and emphasis will shape our year together at St. John.

Our theme verse for the year is Jeremiah 6:16, "Thus says the LORD: 'Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls." I hope you will commit this verse to memory with me. We have resources to help.




